If it is sold out, the fee will not be refunded. Feed the deer in the maple forest in the Nara Park area.</p> <p>An urban park located at the foot of Mount Wakakusa in Nara City. <u>Todaiji Temple</u>, <u>Kasuga Taisha Shrine</u> All of Nara's scenic spots and historic sites are here, and it is a must-visit place when visiting Nara. located near the park <u>Wakakusayama</u> It is a wonderful place to overlook the scenery of Nara, and traditional events such as the "Wakakusa Yakiyama" are held here every January. A leisurely stroll is the best way to visit the park. There is also the largest concentration of deer here. Feeding the cute deer is also the biggest attraction for tourists. The deer here are also very spiritual. They will come to tourists when they see deer cakes in their hands, so you need to be careful of groups of deer that will knock you down. (Reference price of deer senbei is 200 yen/10 yuan)</p> <p>Recommended attractions: Free activities, please bear your own expenses (it is recommended to choose a place to visit based on the actual situation and preferences~)</p> <p>Attractions 【Todaiji Temple】 Also known as the Dai Kegon Temple, it was built in 752 by Emperor Shomu to enshrine the Great Buddha and serve as the main temple of Japanese temples. It is the headquarters of the Kegon Sect. Two fires destroyed the building, and the current one was rebuilt in 1692 and is two-thirds of the original building. The main Buddha Hall of Todaiji Temple, with a front width of 57 meters and a depth of 50 meters, is the largest wooden building in the world. In the Great Buddha Hall, there is a large Buddha statue of 99 Lushuna Buddha that is more than 15 meters high. There are also South Gate, February Hall, March Hall, etc. in Dongdai Temple. (Admission fee: Todaiji Temple Main Hall: 600 yen for adults, 300 yen for children; Todaiji Main Hall + Museum: 1,000 yen for adults, 400 yen for children) 【Kasuga Taisha Shrine】 Kasuga Taisha Shrine is located in Nara Park, Nara City, Nara Prefecture, Japan. It was built in the second year of Wado (710). The gods enshrined in the shrine include Wu Ong Chui Ming, Jing Jin Zhu Ming, Tian Erwu Gen Ming and Bi Mai God. The regular festival day of the shrine is March 13 (Spring Festival), and the builder is Fujiwara Fuhito. It is listed as a World Cultural Heritage as part of the historical relics of ancient Nara and one of the twenty-two shrines. The 1.5-kilometer-long approach starts from a red torii gate and is flanked by towering cedar and white birch trees. Native forest. There are also more than 2,000 donated large and small stone lanterns, as well as Nara deer hiding in the forest. (Admission fee: free outside the shrine, 500 yen for the main shrine)</p> <p>Lunch recommendation (Please bear your own expenses)</p>

It is a traditional Japanese cuisine hidden among Kasuga Taisha Shrine and the deer. The most famous meal of the tea house is called "Manyo porridge". Manyo porridge is made with different flavors. It is made from seasonal plants, so it has different flavors in different months. In addition to the deliciousness, it also has a bit of random fun. It is the best choice to replenish energy after visiting Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Travelers who love to try new things can enjoy it. Don't miss it. Address: 160 Kasugano-cho, Nara City, Nara Prefecture</p> <p>麵庵安 Udon is the national delicacy of the entire Kansai region. Located in the Nara Shopping Street, Mono-an is also one of Nara's most popular queuing shops. The most popular dish is "Udon noodle", which is udon noodles wrapped in tofu skin. The matcha ice cream and matcha cakes all over the street are top-notch, and even the soba noodles can be green matcha. For literature lovers, this is a paradise for literature and art. The last ten stories of the literary masterpiece "The Tale of Genji" known as Japan's Dream of Red Mansions took place in Uji. Anyone who has read "The Tale of Genji" wants to come here to trace the love and hatred of Japanese nobles.</p> <p>Recommended tour routes (It is recommended to choose one of the activities) Recommendation 1: Byodo-in Omotesando Matcha Street Recommendation 2: The Tale of Genji Museum</p> <p>Attractions (Please bear your own expenses) 【Byodoin】 It is a representative of the pond-spring boat-style temple gardens of the Heian period. It was listed as a World Cultural Heritage by UNESCO in 1994. The most famous one is the "Phoenix Hall". The building extends towards the two wings, making it look like a phoenix is about to spread its wings and fly. Inside is enshrined "<u>Amitabha Tathagata</u>". The seated statue of Buddha has been listed as a national treasure and has its image on the 10 yen coin. (Admission fee: Uji River is free, Byodo-in is 600 yen for adults, 400 yen for junior high school and high school students, 300 yen for elementary school students, Phoenix Hall requires an additional admission fee of 300 yen per person) 【The Tale of Genji Museum】 Multimedia sound and light effects are used to introduce the charm and outline of The Tale of Genji with bright and clear high-definition images, and a model of Rokujo-in, which symbolizes the glory and wealth of Genji, is on display. If you browse quickly, you can go around the whole place in about 2 minutes; but if you watch it carefully, 1 or 2 hours may be too little. At the same time, games of nobles such as "Gobe", "Go", and "Sugoroku" are displayed in conjunction with the seasons, as well as events held regularly every year during the Heian period, and the culture of the dynasty is introduced in an easy-to-understand manner. (Admission fee: 500 yen for adults, 250 yen for elementary and junior high school students, closed on Mondays)</p> <p>Recommended old matcha shop in Uji (Please bear your own expenses) 【Dui Feng An】 It is far opposite the Phoenix Hall, so it is named Duihoan. Address: 2 Ujitagawa, Uji City, Kyoto Prefecture 【Nakamura Fujiyoshi Uji Main Store】 A popular dessert shop where you can enjoy exclusive ice cream desserts served in bamboo tubes and made with high-grade Uji tea. Address: Uji 1-10, Uji-shi, Kyoto Prefecture 【Ito Kuemon Main Store】 A representative long-established tea shop in Uji, Kyoto, the dine-in Matcha parfait and Matcha soba are well worth a try. It is a neighborhood hot spring immersed in the warmth of thousands of years. The hot spring water gushes out from 1,111 meters underground. The traditional architecture created by high technology creates a pure Japanese space with a relaxing mood, just like the flowing water of a mountain hot spring bath. You can enjoy this moment of</p>

		healing and tranquility during your leisure time. There are three inner soups and one outer soup, as well as a wealth of dining options. (Admission fee is at your own expense: 1,000 yen for adults and 500 yen for children. If you need towels, meals, etc., additional fees will be charged.
