10:30	Yamanashi Prefecture	<p><b>Lake Kawaguchi seasonal limited itinerary</b></p> <p>Seasonal limited itinerary—Special plan to see the four seasons changes of Mount Fuji (you can have free lunch here, lunch expenses are at your own expense)</p> <p>▼Lake Kawaguchi Oishi Park (11/24-4/12, 5/27-7/10, 60 minutes for this attraction)</p> <p>Every spring, it is the most classic spot to take photos with Mount Fuji and cherry blossoms.</p> <p>Every summer, the lavender in Oishi Park on the shore of Lake Kawaguchi is in full bloom, covering the park with a purple carpet, which contrasts with the scenery of Mount Fuji and is breathtakingly beautiful. This is also the venue for the Kawaguchiko Herb Festival. (Lavender from late June to mid-July)</p> <p>▼Lake Motosu Fuji Shibazakura Festival (April 13-May 26 60 minutes for this attraction)</p> <p>This is the largest Shibazakura Festival in the metropolitan area. It is held regularly every year. It is the largest scale in Japan's metropolitan area. About 800,000 shibazakura trees bloom on the vast plains under Mount Fuji. The colors are bright and beautiful. It is a festival of flowers. . For more than a month from April to late May every year, the largest 800,000 shibazakura trees gradually bloom on the shores of Lake Kawaguchi in Yamanashi Prefecture, forming like a "rainbow on the ground", the gorgeous shibazakura trees, the blue sky and the white snow on Mount Fuji Excellent scenery, fascinating. This rare event once a year is waiting for your participation and visit. The shores of Lake Fujikawaguchi are colorfully decorated with red maples, and the magnificent golden autumn scenery is mesmerizing.</p>
12:10	Yamanashi Prefecture	<p><b>▼Soak in the hot springs at Lake Yamanaka and see Mount Fuji (stay for 70 minutes)</b></p> <p>Lake Yamanaka is the only lake among the Fuji Five Lakes with a natural river outflow. It is also the largest and shallowest lake among the five lakes (only 13.3 meters). Mount Fuji, which can be seen from Lake Yamanaka, has long ridges drawn to the left and right, and it looks very charming. Swans are called white birds in Japan. Every year from February to April, even in the severe cold, swans will fly here to lay eggs and give birth. Because tourists often feed them, the swans sometimes make a special trip to get close to the tourists. Therefore, Yamanaka Lake is also called the "Lake of White Birds." 14:00	Yamanashi Prefecture	<p><b>▼Internet celebrity check-in resort-Arakurayama Sengen Park-the perfect location to enjoy the panoramic view of Mount Fuji (about 1 hour)</b></p> <p><b>(The itinerary is from October 1st to April 25th, going to Asama Park in Arashiyama, but not going to the fifth station of Mount Fuji.)</b></p> <p>The new Internet celebrity attraction is known as one of the "21 places that photographers around the world must visit before they die." This is an excellent location to enjoy the panoramic view of Mount Fuji. Climb the 397 steps near the main shrine, and the five-story Churei Pagoda will come into view. You can take photos of the "five-story pagoda, Mount Fuji, and the street view at the foot of the mountain" all at once. Visitors from all over the world Photographers and tourists flock here to enjoy this scenery. Not only the cherry blossoms in spring, but also the fresh greenery in summer, red leaves in autumn, and snowy scenery in winter are all very beautiful. In addition to admiring the stunning scenery of Mount Fuji, you can also overlook the charming Fujiyoshida city. street view.</p> <p><b>▼Mount Fuji 5th station (about 40 minutes)</b></p> <p><b>(The itinerary is from April 26th to September 30th, going to the fifth station of Mount Fuji, but not going to Asama Park in Arashiyama.)</b></p> <p><b>See Mount Fuji from a closer distance! The popular areas are mainly concentrated in the area spread out from Shinjuku Station to the surrounding areas, including Shinjuku Exit, West Exit, South Exit and other commercial districts. In addition, there are other well-known attractions such as Shinjuku Gyoen National Garden for cherry blossom viewing, Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building, and Golden Street. Tokyo Station Hotel (Tokyo Station Hotel) is located in Chiyoda District, Tokyo, Japan, in the center of the Marunouchi business district. It is a composite station with upper and lower platforms.
