10:00	Wak aya ma	<p>▼Visit the popular cat stationmaster – Kishi Station – Learn the story of the legendary cat stationmaster saving the station that is about to collapse (about 70 minutes)</p> <p>Kishi Station (Kishi Station) is a small station located in Wakayama Prefecture, Japan, and belongs to the terminus of the Wakayama Electric Railway Kishigawa Line. This small station, which was originally on the verge of abandonment, has become a nationally famous tourist destination because of a cat named "Tama".</p> <p>Legendary Cat Webmaster - Tama</p> <p>In 2006, Wakayama Electric Railway introduced a "cat stationmaster" system at Kishi Station due to labor costs, and officially appointed the 8-year-old three-flower cat "Kotama" (Tama), a cat resident in the station, as the station manager.</p> <p>The stationmaster "goes to work" every day to patrol the station and greets visiting passengers cordially, and his cute image quickly attracted media attention and attracted a large number of tourists to check in.</p> <p>Save an endangered railway line</p> <p>Due to the decrease in passengers, the Kishigawa Line once faced a crisis of abandonment. The appearance of the Tama stationmaster not only brought popularity, but also led to the development of the economy along the line: from surrounding shops and souvenirs to the "cat-themed train", and even the construction of a new station building at Kishi Station in the shape of a cat, which has become a symbol of regional rejuvenation.</p> <p>The "cat culture" that is inherited and continued</p> <p>After the death of Stationmaster Tama (who passed away in June 2015), he was revered as the "Honorary Permanent Stationmaster", and his successor, the cat "Nitama" (Nitama), continued to serve as the stationmaster, maintaining people's love for this heartwarming story.</p>

Kishi Station is not only a transportation facility, but also a touching story of mutual protection between people and animals, communities and railways.

There are three special trains on the whole line: Xiaoyu, strawberry and toys, and in addition to the cat stationmaster, there are also meow cafes, meow seals, and meow houses. The old train station is beautifully furnished and sells all kinds of cute peripherals, making it a must-visit attraction for cat lovers. **(Note: On Wednesday and Thursday, the cat webmaster Eryu is on duty, replaced by the trainee webmaster Fouryu on duty).**

*Special special train (10:38 Kishi Station ~ 10:50 Ita Kiso Station) **The experience fee is included**

(the daily special train at 10:38 is changed, so you can look forward to what kind of special train you can experience on the day^).

▼Shirahama Toretore Market --- the largest seafood market in western Japan to enjoy delicious seafood Japanese food (about 120 minutes, including free lunch in the market, please pay at your own expense)

Located in Waka-Shirahama's Toretore, it gathers the freshest catches in Shirahama and is the largest Nanki Shirahama seafood market in western Japan. Tuna dismantling shows are held here 2~3 times a day (**dismantling time is random**) (**please note that the tuna dismantling show will be canceled in case of special circumstances**). During the performance, the little master is equally technical and entertaining, and the audience also holds their breath and occasionally exclaims some uncontrollably, and the little brother explains the composition of tuna while dissecting it, etc., which is rare to see elsewhere. The multi-opera tourist fish market is a must-see when visiting Shirahama, Wakayama, where you can not only eat the freshest seafood, but also buy many souvenirs and processed products to take home.

Lunch recommendation: There are several restaurants and barbecue restaurants in the market where you can freely enjoy fresh seafood. In addition to a wide variety of fresh sashimi, there are also a variety of Wakayama/Shirahama souvenirs such as seafood, dried overnight, and sake. You can also use the fresh seafood stones in Shirahama Market for a self-service BBQ~ BBQ barbecue seat Reference price: Adults 800 yen/person Children 500 yen/person (**ingredients need to be purchased by yourself, ingredients are purchased after registration**) Admission time: 90 minutes Soft drinks can be enjoyed at the counter, and take-out ingredients and drinks are not allowed

▼Toretore Onsen (**experience at your own expense, please pay for yourself**)

Shirahama Onsen in Wakayama is listed as one of the "Three Oldest Onsen (Koyu) in Japan" along with Arima Onsen (Hyogo Prefecture) and Dogo Onsen (Ehime Prefecture). Since the Asuka and Nara dynasties, it has been known for its "Murou no Onyu" and "Ki no Onyu", and the beautiful depictions of the white sandy beach can be seen in the ancient Japanese books "Nihon Shoki" and "Manyoshu". Many emperors and court members have visited the area in the past, and it is a super hot spring resort with a long history of more than 1,350 years. At the same time, Shirahama Onsen is also known as the "Three Major Hot Springs in Japan" with Beppu Onsen and Atami Onsen, and also has Japan's first salt brick bedrock bath~ The hot spring quality is sodium bicarbonate spring.

ToreTore no Yu Reference admission fee: Adults 800 yen (junior high school students and above) Children 400 yen (3 years old and over, ~12 years old and younger) Towel 160 yen / Bath towel 410 yen.

	<p>Senjojiki (about 30 minutes)</p> <p>Senjojiki is a unique landscape located on the west coast of Shirahama City, Wakayama Prefecture, where sandstone geology has been eroded by the Pacific Ocean over time, forming layers of complex terrain that look like many bedrock plates stacked on top of each other from a distance. This section of the coast has a total area of about 4 hectares and can hold 1,000 tatami mats (Japanese people are used to measuring the area by the size of tatami mats), so it is called "Senjojiki", and it has become a scenic spot in Shirahama along with Sandanbei and Engetsujima. Senjojiki is a sunset viewing spot that locals are proud of, and when the weather is clear, you can see the whole process of the sun slowly sinking into the Pacific Ocean, and this beautiful scenery has also been selected as one of the "100 Best Sunsets in Japan", plus the remote location with few people, the unique landform, and the rolling waves of the Pacific Ocean, if you watch the sunset here, you will feel like you are at the end of the world.</p> <p>▼ Sandan Wall, Deep into the Sandan Cave Beneath the Cliff Spectacular Cliffs and Exciting Past (about 30 minutes)</p> <p>Sandan Wall, part of Nokumano National Park, is a famous scenic spot in Shirahama and a sacred place for lovers. Sandanbi is a famous cliffs and cliffs on the coast of Shirahama Town, Nishimurao District, Wakayama Prefecture. The third section wall is actually a large rock wall with a length of 2 kilometers and a height of 50-60 meters in the sea. At the end of the cliff, there is an observation deck for visitors to enjoy the sea view of Nanki. The cliffs here are not only a natural spectacle, but also a variety of historical events that have been staged under the cliffs for centuries. (During the Heian period (794-1185), local pirates hid in the caves of Sandanbeki.) A cave formed by seawater erosion is formed 36 meters underground, and you can take the elevator to visit the inside of the cave. Imagine yourself as a modern-day version of Captain Jack Sparrow, taking an elevator down into a 36-meter-deep cavern and exploring the damp, dark passages. The cave is filled with various artifacts and replicas related to piracy, as well as various strange traces left by natural erosion. Admission is required. Tickets are at your own expense, reference ticket prices: Adults: 1,500 yen, children aged 6-11: 750 yen, children under 6 years old are free</p>
15:05	<p>Shirahama</p> <p>End the day's tour happily and start the return. The return time is for reference only, and may return early due to the smooth itinerary of the day, good road conditions, etc.</p>
16:10	<p>return</p> <p>Shinsai Bridge and Daodun Pavilion area</p> <p>Guests who have boarded and dropped off the package at the meeting point will disband in the Shinsaibashi area and end the tour.</p> <p>Shinsaibashi: One of Osaka's most famous shopping streets, home to large department stores, drugstore chains, old brand stores, and small shops. There are all kinds of products of all grades and styles, and Hello kitty and Disney specialty stores have also settled here. It is also a gathering place for drugstores that MM's like, and cosmetics and skin care products can be found at will. Most stores are equipped with Chinese shopping guides and support UnionPay card payment, so you can easily enjoy shopping.</p> <p>Dotonbori: Synonymous with Osaka's cuisine, there is never a time to rest in the street during the day or at night. As the birthplace of Osaka's so-called "eating and lying down" food culture, Dotonbori has many gourmet snacks such as octopus meatballs,</p>
